

AN ORDINANCE

2011-11-17-0966

AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF “INDUSTRY DRIVE” TO “GABRIEL’S PLACE” BEGINNING AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH “SENTINEL DRIVE” AND CONTINUING ALONG ITS LENGTH UP TO AND INCLUDING ITS CUL-DE-SAC, LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 10, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, at the request of Christina Gonzalez to honor Johnny D. Gabriel for his contributions to the San Antonio community through the Rey Feo Scholarship Program, the Consejo Education Foundation, Lo Bello de San Antonio Women’s Club, and many other organizations promoting education, the renaming of Industry Drive to Gabriel’s Place was initiated; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department staff was tasked with implementing this request through the street renaming process as required by the Chapter 6 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, this request was forwarded to and reviewed by all City of San Antonio Departments and outside agencies and no opposition was identified; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted a technical review finding it to conform to City Code requirements for renaming of public streets; and

WHEREAS, notice of this request to rename said street was properly posted at City Hall, notice was mailed to affected property owners, and notice was disseminated through public service announcements, the notice requirements for renaming of the street has been satisfied in accordance with Chapter 6 of the City Code and further, no written opposition has been received to the name change from affected property owners; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the Planning Commission was held on September 28, 2011 allowing all interested persons to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission approved a motion to support the street name change of Industry Drive to Gabriel’s Place; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The city-owned street known as Industry Drive located in City Council District 10 beginning at its intersection with Sentinel Drive and continuing along its length up to and including its cul-de-sac is hereby renamed Gabriel’s Place. City staff is directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.


SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance in the amount of \$500.00 will be deposited into Fund 29097000, General Ledger 4406775 and Internal Order 229000000000.

SECTION 3. Funds generated by this ordinance in the amount of \$173.36 will be deposited into Fund 11001000, General Ledger 6301120 and Internal Order 223000000158.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it becomes effective on the 27th of November, 2011.




