AN ORDINANCE (1330)

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF MARTIN WRIGHT ELECTRIC CO. TO FURNISH THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH ITS REQUIREMENTS OF INCANDESCENT LAMPS FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE (12) MONTHS BEGINNING JUNE 1ST, 1942 AND ENDING MAY 31ST, 1943.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the proposal of Martin-Wright Electric Co., of 1001 Navarro Street, San Antonio, Texas, dated May 12, 1942, attached hereto and made a part hereof, to furnish the City of San Antonio with its requirements of incandescent lamps for the period of twelve (12) months beginning June 1st, 1942 and ending May 31st, 1943, with discounts of 30% for case lot and 25% in broken lots, with 2% cash discount if paid on or before the 10th of the month following purchase, and a rebate to the City of San Antonio of the difference between discounts of 30% and 32% in case lots and 25% and 27% in broken lots if the purchases of the City of San Antonio net \$3500.00 or more during said period, be and the same is hereby accepted.

2. All other bids are hereby rejected.
