AN ORDINANCE **68853**

ORDERING THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 6TH DAY OF MAY, 1989, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

* * * * *

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. That the regular municipal election be, and the same is ordered hereby to be held on Saturday, the 6th day of May, A.D., 1989, in accordance with the laws of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, and the official ballots for said election will be prepared in accordance with state statutes for the election of the following municipal officers, to-wit:

Ten members of the Council, Place 1 through Place 10, being one each to be elected from districts or wards numbered accordingly (all as provided by Section 4 of the City Charter), each for a term of two years beginning on the first day of June, 1989; and one member to be elected as Mayor, Place 11, by a majority of all qualified voters voting in said election as provided in Sections 4 and 9 of the City Charter.

SECTION 2. Said election shall be held as prescribed by law, in the City of San Antonio at the following polling or voting places in the several precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock P.M.:

SECTION 3. Voting at said election shall be done by the use of voting machines, paper ballots or the electronic voting system as determined by the City Clerk, and the City Council of the City of San Antonio does determine hereby that voting machines, paper ballots or electronic voting system shall be used for the casting of absentee votes at this election, and voting machines shall be placed in the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas and at temporary branch offices (Attachment II) established for the purpose of conducting absentee voting by personal appearance. The City Clerk, or Assistant City

Clerk, is authorized and charged to perform the functions provided by law in the casting of absentee ballots and shall hold such election, and ballots shall be cast commencing April 17, 1989, and ending May 2, 1989; all in the method, manner and time made and provided by the Statutes of the State of Texas on this subject.

SECTION 4. The Mayor and City Council shall appoint the election officers to hold said election, in accordance with law, including an Absentee Ballot Board which shall count and canvass the absentee ballots cast at said election.

SECTION 5. Notice of said election shall be given by publishing a substantial copy of this Ordinance in a daily newspaper of general circulation published in the City, not less than 30 days before the date of the election.



SUMMARY:

This ordinance officially calls the Regular Municipal Election for May 6, 1989 from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. It authorizes the printing of ballots, establishes voting places, sets the routine procedures for absentee voting, authorizes the City Clerk and her assistants to perform election duties, authorizes the Mayor and City Council to appoint election officers, and provides for lawful public notice.

CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL IS NECESSARY IN ORDER TO SUBMIT THE ORDINANCE TO THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT.

POLICY ANALYSIS:

The calendar leading up to the May 6th election is as follows:


February 9, 1989	Council approves the ordinance calling the City Council regular election.
February 10, 1989	Notification to the Justice Department (deadline February 17th - 60 days before absentee voting period).
March 23, 1989	City Council approves ordinances awarding bids on "Printing of Election Supplies" and "Transporting of Voting Machines."
March 24, 1989	Publication of Notice of Election in the Commercial Recorder, San Antonio Light, and Express-News.
March 27, 1989	Ballot to printer.
April 17, 1989	Absentee voting begins.
May 2, 1989	Absentee voting ends.
May 6, 1989	Election Day.
May 8, 1989	Special Council meeting to canvass election returns and declare results.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funds for the election are included in the adopted budget of the City Clerk's office.

I recommend that this ordinance be approved.
