HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS,  
ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 26TH, 1943, AT 10:00 O'CLOCK, A. M.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, and Steffler. Absent: Anderson. Mayor Mauermann presiding.
