AN ORDINANCE **47586**

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD THE 15TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1977, ON TWO PROPOSITIONS TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held on the 15th day of January, 1977, on two propositions to amend the Charter of the City of San Antonio, as provided by Ordinance Number 47304 (incorporated herein by reference) adopted October 27, 1976; and

WHEREAS, said election was held and the returns made all according to law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council met on January 17, 1977, to canvass the returns of said election; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council, having canvassed the returns of the said special election held January 15, 1977, on two propositions to amend the Charter of the City of San Antonio, does hereby find and declare the results of this election to be as follows:

PROPOSITION #1. Shall Sections 4, 13, 15 and 26 of the Charter of the City of San Antonio be amended providing for an increase in the membership of the City Council from 9 to 11 members, 10 of whom shall be elected from districts or wards; providing residence requirements; providing for establishment of 10 districts or wards; providing for a quorum; providing that an affirmative vote of at least 8 members shall be required to pass an ordinance or resolution as an emergency measure; and providing for recall of a Council Member.

YES: 31,530 Votes      NO: 29,857 Votes

PROPOSITION #2. Shall the Charter of the City of San Antonio be amended to provide authority to change the City tax year to the period January 1 through December 31, in one or more stages, and to make necessary changes in related dates; and to provide authority to change the fiscal and budget year in the same manner to the period October 1 through September 30, in one or more stages, and to make necessary changes in related dates; and to authorize any necessary borrowing for financing during transition period(s), and the levy of a sufficient tax to pay interest thereon and to provide the required sinking fund.

YES: 33,174 Votes      NO: 22,229 Votes

SECTION 2. The Council finds and declares that a majority of the votes cast on Propositions #1 and #2, were cast in favor of their adoption.

SECTION 3. The City Council, therefore, pursuant to law declares that Propositions #1 and #2, (as set out in full in Section 1 of the aforementioned Ord. #47304) have been adopted and shall become a part of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, and said charter is so amended.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to Article 1173 (Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), the City Manager shall, as soon as practicable, certify to the Secretary

of State an authenticated copy of Propositions #1 and #2, approved by the qualified voters of the City amending the Charter of the City of San Antonio.

SECTION 5. Pursuant to Article 1174, the City Clerk shall record the amendments so adopted at length upon the records of the City.

SECTION 6. This ordinance and the Charter amendments (propositions) adopted shall become effective immediately unless otherwise provided in the aforesaid Ordinance 47304.
