AN ORDINANCE:

DECLARING THE CANVASSING AND THE RESULT OF
AN ELECTION ON THE 12TH OF MAY, 1931.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. Came on this 13th day of May, A. D. 1931, regularly to be canvassed the returns of the regular municipal election held on the 12th day of May, 1931, to determine the elective officers of the City of San Antonio under its Charter for the ensuing term of office of two years;
2. And the Mayor and Commissioners having met to canvass the returns and to declare the result of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all matters of fact thereto appertaining, we, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, do hereby find and declare the result of said election to be as tabulated and attached hereto.
3. And it appearing to the Mayor and Commissioners that the names of the candidates were submitted, and that the election was held and conducted, and that the returns thereof were made, all as required by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, the proclamation of the Mayor and the law for such cases made and provided, and that at said election there was cast respectively for each of said candidates, the aggregate number of votes "FOR" and the aggregate number of votes "AGAINST", all as shown by the report.
4. And the Mayor and Commissioners having first canvassed said returns and said reports and having found the same in all things correct, the same was thereupon adopted by unanimous vote of the Mayor and Commissioners and it is further ordered that the elective officers for the two years following the 1st day of June, A. D. 1931, are as follows: C. M. Chambers, Mayor; Frank H. Bushick, Commissioner of Taxation; Jacob Rubiola, Commissioner of Sanitation, Parks and Public Property; Paul E. Steffler, Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements; and Phil Wright, Commissioner of Police and Fire; and each of them were elected by a majority vote of the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio voting at said election and they and each of them are hereby declared to be the lawful and duly elected officers of the City of San Antonio.
5. The attached tabulated report of the returns of said election is hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance for all intents and purposes.
6. PASSED AND APPROVED, this 13th day of May, A. D. 1931.
