SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,
HELD IN THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER STEFFLER, AT ELEVEN O'CLOCK,
A. M., ON TUESDAY, THE EIGHTH DAY OF APRIL, A. D. 1947.

PRESENT: MAUERMANN, CALLAGHAN, HEIN, STEFFLER AND ANDERSON; MAYOR MAUERMANN, PRESIDING.

The Clerk read the call, as follows:

April 7, 1947.

To the Commissioner of the City of San Antonio:

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the charter of the City of San Antonio, I hereby call you in Special Session, to be held at 11:00 A. M. on Tuesday, April 8th, 1947, in Commissioner Steffler's office of the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas, to consider and act upon the following:

An ordinance ordering an election on the 13th day of May, 1947, for members of the Board of Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

An ordinance making contract with the County of Bexar for the rental of voting machines for the election on the 13th day of May, A.D. 1947.

An ordinance making a contract with Roy J. Jeffers for the preparation of the voting machines.

An ordinance authorizing the issuance of \$500,00 refunding interregional highway bonds, series A-45, of the City of San Antonio, confirming the sale thereof, and providing for the levy and collection of taxes to pay principal of and interest on said bonds.
