SECTION ONE: That a public necessity exists for the widening and straightening of said Bonham Street between the points aforementioned, and that the roll and report of the City Engineer, with the plans and other documents attached thereto are hereby approved and adopted and the new lines of said street are hereby designated as shown upon such plans and said improvement is hereby ordered made.

SECTION TWO: That in the opinion of the Commissioners it is necessary and proper to assess a part of the cost of said improvements against the owners of property abutting thereon and against their property, and it is so ordered.

SECTION THREE: That as appears from said roll and report as here now approved by the Commissioners, the total amount proposed to be assessed against the owners of abutting property is (\$32,857.86); that the amount per front foot to be assessed against such property owners on an average is estimated to be Thirty and 88/100 (\$30.88) Dollars.
