

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, JUNE 19TH, A.D.1919, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Ray Lambert, Mayor-protem presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann and Wright. Absent, Mayor Bell.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

A hearing was given to owners of property interested in the improvement of Avenue D, from Third Street to Tenth Street, as recorded on page 43 of the Record of Hearings.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation:
 Womans Board of City Missions M.E.Church South, for exemption from taxation.
 Toepperwein Hdware Store for refund of taxes.
 A.Hardman, for refund of taxes.
 L.Jake Zotz, for refund of taxes.

Petition for the extention of street car service to the Municipal Rifle Range, and for other improvements, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Commissioner Heuermann introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Lambert, Coy, Heuermann, Wright.

No. 40 *MC-971* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$250.00 to pay for feed for street cleaning department.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Two Hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Felix Herman for feed for animals in Street Cleaning Department.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

No. 41 *-972* AN ORDINANCE
 Appropriating \$71.00 to reimburse the Incidental Expenditures Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$71.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to reimburse the Incidental Expenditures Fund for fines remitted by order of the Mayor and paid by the City Clerk out of said Incidental Expenditures Fund during part of the month of June, 1919

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

Bids for furnishing the City with one wagon for use of the Street Cleaning Department were opened and referred to the Purchasing Agent.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
