No. 435 *MC-897* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$2685.59 to pay City Day Laborers for week ending May, 10, 1919

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$2685.59 be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay City Day Laborers for week ending May 10, 1919, as follows:

No. 436 *-898* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$27.00 out of the Judgement Fund to pay B.F. Stuart for preparation of statement of facts.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Twenty Seven (\$27.00) Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the Judgement Fund, to pay B.F. Stuart for preparing statement of Facts of cause No. b-11885, John Pfeiffer vs City of San Antonio.

No. 437 *-899* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$37.50 to pay court costs in case of Frank Newnam vs. City of San Antonio, and the sum of \$25.50 to pay court costs in case of John Pfeiffer vs City of San Antonio, both of said sums to be paid out of the Judgement Fund, and warrants for each to be payable to Osceola Archer, District Clerk of Bexar County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Thirty-seven and 50/100 (\$37.50) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Judgement Fund, to pay court costs in Cause No.B-8431, Frank Newnam vs City of San Antonio, in the 45th District Court of Bexar County; and

That the sum of Twenty Five and 50/100 (\$25.40) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Judgement Fund, to pay Court Costs in Cause No.B-11785, John Pfeiffer vs City of San Antonio, in the 73rd District Court of Bexar County.

The following resolution was read and adopted:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the petition of the Magnolia Petroleum Company for permission to construct and maintain a new and enlarged gasoline filling station on the North part of New City Block 782, in this City, with additional drive in sidewalk crossings therefor on South Alamo Street, South Presa Street and Garden Street, be and the same is hereby granted and allowed in accordance with said petition, and it is hereby ordered that all requisite permits be issued in due time by officers of the City for the construction and installation of said work.

Honorable Mayor and Commissioners,  
City of San Antonio, Texas.  
Gentlemen:

You are respectfully advised that the Magnolia Petroleum Company is about to purchase at the cost of Fifty Three Thousand Dollars, the North part of New City Block No. 782, in this City, situated on the South side of South Alamo Street, and extending back about 100 feet on Garden Street and about 181 feet on South Presa Street.

The Magnolia Company now maintains on this property, under permit heretofore granted by your Honorable Board, a Drive-in Gasoline Filling Station, on the corner of South Alamo and South Presa Streets. Said premises as heretofore leased by the Magnolia Company, have proved to small, and the Company has been obliged to purchase said land to obtain room to accommodate such business conveniently for the people of the Southern part of the City.

The Company desires to move the old blacksmith shop and other unsightly structures now on said premises, and to construct and maintain a new and expensive gasoline filling station, of handsome style and fireproof materials, and to cost about \$12000.00, and proposes to improve and park a part of said premises, all in such manner as to make said property an ornament to said neighborhood. For access to and exit from said New Filling station the Company will desire to alter and enlarge its drive-in facilities, so as to permit new and enlarges drive-in crossings of the sidewalks, adjacent to the above mentioned property, on South Alamo Street and on Garden and South Presa Street. The Company proposes to install all this work in conformity with the ordinances of the City applicable thereto.

In order to carry out said plans with the approval of your Honorable Board, the Magnolia Petroleum Company begs leave to submit herewith, for your inspection, sketches of said proposed improvements; and hereby respectfully petitions that your Honorable Body do grant, and order the issuance of, all requisite permits for the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid filling station, and the drive-in sidewalk crossings, with all usual appurtenances.


