AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating funds to pay City's proportion of maintaining R.B.Green Memorial Hospital.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$7,620.74 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund to pay City's proportion for maintenance of R.B.Green Memorial Hospital as follows:

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of \$250,000. out of the 1922 General Fund to pay the City Natl Bank of San Antonio, Texas, to retire notes Nos. 13,14,15 & 16 & 17 of a series of notes Nos. 1 to 46 inclusive, in the principal sum of \$50,000 each, payable to the City National Bank; also appropriating the sum of \$4500 out of the 1922 General Fund, for Contingencies, to pay interest on said five notes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the sum of \$250,000 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund, payable to the City National Bank of San Antonio, Texas, to retire notes Nos 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 of a series of notes Nos. 1 to 46 inclusive, in the principal sum of \$50,000 each, payable to the City National Bank, dated January 15, 1923, bearing interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, maturing on or before June 1, 1923; said notes having been issued in pursuance to an ordinance passed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 15th day of January, 1923, which ordinance is recorded in Vol E, page 336 et seq.; of the Minutes of the Commissioners on file in the City Clerks office.

SECTION TWO: That the sum of \$4500 or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund, Contingencies Department, payable to the said City National Bank to pay interest on said notes Nos. 13,14,15,16 and 17 of said series of notes, said interest being at the rate of five per cent per annum from February 10, 1923 to date of retirement.

SECTION THREE: The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to prepare proper warrant or warrants in said amounts, and deliver same to said City National Bank upon date of payment of said amounts.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating funds to pay interest on notes.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of (\$1600) Sixteen Hundred Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund (Contingencies Dept) payable to City National Bank to pay interest on notes Nos 11 and 12, of a series of notes Nos 1 to 46 inc, said interest being at the rate of five per cent per annum, from February 10, 1923 to date of retirement.

The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to prepare proper warrant or warrants to cover said interest.

AN ORDINANCE

THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

WHEREAS, Kenneth Wimer, being the owner of said property, did lay out, map and improve the Forty Five (45) acres of land lying between the Fredericksburg Road and the extension of Woodlawn Avenue, West of the S.A & A.P.R.R. Co. track and East of Zarzamora Street, the western boundary line of said property being Zarzamora Street, and the name given to said addition being Woodlawn Place Addition; and

WHEREAS, under date of January 30, 1923, Kenneth Wimer did file in the office of the County Clerk of Bexar County, Texas, the following dedication, to-wit:

"THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF BEXAR:

I, Kenneth Wimer, owner of Woodlawn Place, consisting of forty five (45) acres of land, acquired by me by deed from the University of Cincinnati and Julia W. Anderson, City Blocks Nos 1938, 1947, 1948, 1957, and Lots 1 to 6 inclusive, lots 12 to 47 inclusive, in New City Block 1958, and lots 1 to 9 inclusive, lots 12 to 47 inclusive, in New City Block 1967, acquired by deed from R.B. Greathouse; said New City Blocks 1938, 1947, 1948, 1957, 1958, and 1967, as shown by plat hereto attached, being a subdivision of such new city blocks in accordance with said plat hereto attached, do hereby dedicate to the public for its use, behoof, and benefit forever, all of the sections of such streets as are shown by the map hereto attached, and all of the alleys extending through said blocks as shown by said plat, and in accordance therewith, save and except, however, the roads indicated on said map or plat as the West Drive and East Drive, which are hereby reserved for the use of the owners of the lots in the blocks shown on said map or plat.
