AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PASSED AND APPROVED 3 NOVEMBER, 1938, ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE HEIGHT, NUMBER OF STORIES AND SIZE OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES; PER CENT OF LOT THAT MAY BE OCCUPIED; THE SIZE OF YARDS, COURTS AND OPEN SPACES; DENSITY OF POPULATION; LOCATION AND USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES AND LAND FOR TRADE, INDUSTRY, RESIDENCE AND OTHER PURPOSES; DIVIDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO INTO DISTRICTS, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, RE-CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REPAIR OR USE OF BUILDING, STRUCTURES, OR LAND WITHIN SUCH DISTRICT; PROVIDING THE UNIFORM REGULATIONS FOR CLASSES OR KINDS OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES AND USES WITHIN THE RESTRICTED DISTRICT; ADOPTING ZONING MAPS DIS-CLOSING VARIOUS DISTRICTS, USE, AREAS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS AND PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO DISTRICTS AND AREAS; PROVIDING FOR A BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND DEFINING THE POWERS THEREOF; TO RE-ZONE: PROPOSITION "B", PORTION OF NORTH PARK BOULEVARD; AND, PROPOSITION "C", PROPERTY AT SOUTH GEVERS, HYACINTH, MILLER AND BREARLY STREETS. 
