MONDAY, NOVEMBER 18TH, A.D.1918. 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of Italian Colony for permit to use Military Plaza and Haymarket Square for Carnival celebration during 6 days in December was granted.

Petition of S.A.Loan and Trust Co. for refund of taxes was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Petition of National Bank of Commerce for permit to erect electric sign was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

The resignation of J.D.Dodson, as Assistant City Attorney, was read and accepted by the Commissioners.
