SUBJECT: Request to move the item regarding a new zoning classification for Golf Courses and Parks out of the Infrastructure and Growth Committee to the Full Council for consideration.

Issue Proposed for Consideration

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest available meeting of the City Council:

I respectfully ask for your concurrence in moving the item regarding a new zoning classification for golf courses and parks out of the Infrastructure and Growth Committee to the Full Council for consideration.

This new designation will streamline the land use designation for golf courses and park lands.

Brief Background

The purpose of this request is to create a specific zoning classification for golf courses and park land. Streamlining the use for private and public golf courses will lessen any confusion about zoning requirements for future golf course development.

This item was originally submitted to the City Clerks office on January 2, 2008.

- Reviewed and passed through the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) on April 28, 2008.
- Staff and Legal reviewed the item and made changes.
- Resubmitted for update and review to the TAC on March 23, 2009.
- Presented to the Zoning Commission and received a unanimous approval on April 8, 2009
- Scheduled for Infrastructure and Growth Committee on April 15, 2009 – was not heard
- Scheduled for a special meeting of the Infrastructure and Growth Committee on April 29, 2009 – Quorum not reached.


This item has been properly vetted by Development Services, the Technical Advisory Committee and the Zoning Commission all with approval.

The Golf Course Zoning District Modification item has been postponed due to the number of

items that are before the committee. Some of those items include other items such as a report on certain CPS Energy Expenses related to nuclear energy, HB 1835 Rough Proportionality, Leon Creek Master Plan, and the CPS Energy Solar Incentives. All of these issues are very important and the timeline for committee action is growing short.

Because of this fact, the Golf Course Zoning District Modification and any other item that staff deems necessary and ready to move forward needs to be sent on to the full council for consideration.




