## AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$387.50 to pay the Western Paving Company, on account of certain expenses incurred in connection with the paving of Ruiz Street.

WHEREAS the City of San Antonio, during the fiscal year 1916 entered into several contracts with the Western Paving Company for the paving of Ruiz Street from Laredo Street to San Jacinto Street; Labor Street from Goliad Street to Carolina Street; and Castro Street from Laredo Street to Navidad Street; and thereafter proposed to said Western Paving Company, the cancellation of said contracts, on account of the depletion of funds necessary for said work, and the Western Paving Company agreed to the cancellation of said contracts under the condition that the City of San Antonio re-imburse said paving company for such amount of expense incurred by it incident to and in connection with securing the agreements of property owners along Ruiz Street and the cost of the execution of the Construction Bond and Maintenance Bond in connection with the work on Ruiz Street,

which condition was accepted by the Commissioners of the City on Oct 16, 1916, all as recorded in Volume B. page 149 of the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Commissioners, and

WHEREAS said expenses have not yet been paid to the Western Paving Company,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, that, the sum of \$387.50 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 General Fund to be paid Western Paving Company in full settlement of the expenses incurred under said proposal adopted Oct. 16, 1916, all as per bills filed herewith covering the cost of said expense.

The following ordinance was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Bell, Coy, Lambert, Heuermann and Lowther.

AN ORDINANCE

-268 Granting temporary permit to Nevelow Brothers to construct and operate a telephone booth on the south east corner of Houston Street Bridge.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. That a temporary permit be and the same is hereby granted to Nevelow Brothers, a firm composed of Sam Nevelow, Nathan Nevelow and I, Nevelow, of San

Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, to build and construct a booth, not to exceed six (6) feet in width and seven (7) feet in depth, adjoining the Maverick Building and on the southeast corner of the Houston Street bridge, to be used as a telephone booth or station, same to be constructed in accordance with and subject to the building rules and regulations now in force or such as may be hereafter enacted, and subject to the inspection and approval of the Building Inspector.

Section 2. That in consideration of the privilege hereby granted, said Nevelow Brothers shall pay to the City of San Antonio a monthly rental of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, which said amount shall be paid on the 1st day of each succeeding month hereafter, until said privilege shall be revoked or canceled by the City of San Antonio.

Section 3. That the privilege hereby granted is a temporary permit only, and by the acceptance of the terms of this ordinance said Nevelow Brothers agree, bind and obligate themselves to remove said structure when requested so to do by said City of San Antonio, and to maintain same in a safe and orderly condition, and subject to the right of the City to cancel said permit at any time; provided, that in the event said Nevelow Brothers shall fail, refuse or neglect to remove same within ten (10) days after having been requested so to do, the City of San Antonio shall be authorized to remove same at the cost and expense of said Nevelow Brothers.

Section 4. That permit shall become effective only upon the filing on the part of the licensees herein of their written acceptance of the terms of the provisions of this ordinance.


