MONDAY, JUNE 5th, A.D.1922, 4 P.M.

PRESENT, Honorable O.B.Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

## ---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of L.R.Parker for permit to operate dancing pavilion Josephine Street and Avenue B was read and referred to the Mayor.

Mrs C.E.Levy, complaining of nuisance 1030 W.French Place was read and referred to Board of Health.

Citizens on Fredericksburg Road requesting that paving be widened was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets, etc.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: Texas East Motors line, for permit to install gasoline pumps and tanks at old Travis Street Fire House.

Central Baptist Church, for permit to erect tent Pruitt Ave & Sommerset Road.  
United Tire Co. for permit to install gasoline tank, 1310 S.Flores Street.

Mr Jno. Sehorn addressed the Commissioners in reference to a claim of Mr Bonnemaision against the City. The matter was taken under advisement.

The bid of Lauterstein for supplying uniforms and caps to the Police and Fire Department was accepted by the Commissioners.  
The matter of the bids for hats was held over.

Bids for paving S.Pine Street, Dakota Street to Porter Street, Pine Street from Commerce to Dakota Streets, Iowa Street, from Palmetto to New Braunfels Avenue; Hackberry to Palmetto and Cherry to Hackberry Streets, were opened and referred to City Engineer for tabulation.

Mayor Black presented the following resolution, which was read and adopted by unanimous vote of the Commissioners.

NOTICE TO BANKS AND TRUST COMPANIES.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio desires to select depositories for City funds for the ensuing period of one year.

NOW THEREFORE, said City hereby invites proposals from each bank, banker or Trust Company in the City of San Antonio, desiring to be selected as such depository of City funds, such proposals duly signed and inclosed under seal, to be delivered to the City Clerk on or before the 3rd day of July A.D.1922, at 4 o'clock p.m. at which time (subject to postponement of one week on order of the Commissioners) the same will be opened at a meeting of said board of Commissioners who will thereupon

make selection and designation of such depository or depositories of City funds, and thereafter receive and consider the depository bonds tendered by such bidders, all as provided by law and charter and ordinances of said City;

Each such proposal shall state the rate of interest, not to less than three per cent on daily balances, payable monthly, which the bidder offers to pay the City.

And each such proposal which contemplates a deposit with the bidder of less than the whole of the funds of the City, shall state whether the bidder desires to become a general depository or a special depository and shall designate the character and amount or proportion of such deposit desired.

And each such bidder proposing to become a general depository will be expected to include or combine in such proposal, or to file in a separate proposal, at the same time, and in the same manner an additional proposal in writing, stating the terms and conditions, upon which such bidder proposes to loan to the City of San Antonio, from time to time as needed, such sum or sums as said Board of Commissioners may desire to borrow for the use of the City for cashing City warrants in anticipation of the receipts of taxes and current revenues of the City, for the current fiscal year, which will be pledged as security for such loans; all as provided by the Charter and ordinances of said City, reference being especially made hereby to what is known as the "Finance Ordinances".

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to cause notice of the foregoing resolution to be published not less than one week before the date above fixed for opening said bids, and to preserve proof of such publication.

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On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
