

ORDINANCE NO. 44595

ORDINANCE CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

THE STATE OF TEXAS :
COUNTY OF BEXAR :
CITY OF SAN ANTONIO :

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City duly ordered an election to be held in said City on the 5TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1974, on the PROPOSITION hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigaged all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding, and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined: that a case of emergency or urgent public necessity exists which requires the holding of the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed, such emergency or urgent public necessity being that the proceeds from the sale of the bonds are required as soon as possible and without delay for necessary and urgently needed public improvements; and that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Vernon's Ann. Civ. St. Article 6252-17.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Ordinance calling said election.

2. That the City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at the election, on the submitted PROPOSITION, by the resident, qualified electors who own taxable property in said City, and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, and who voted at the election:

3. That the City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at the election, on the submitted PROPOSITION, by all other resident, qualified electors of said City who voted at the election:

4. That the City Council officially finds, determines and declares the result of said election to be that the PROPOSITION so submitted has received a favorable majority vote in all respects and has carried, and that the bonds voted thereunder may be issued in accordance with law.

5. That this Ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency measure, to be effective immediately upon enactment, such emergency being that the proceeds from the aforesaid bonds are required as soon as possible for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, and safety.
