

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO

MONDAY, MARCH 30TH, A.D. 1942 10:00 A.M.

TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Gentlemen:

Under the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of San Antonio, by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I call you hereby in a Special Meeting required for the good of the City of San Antonio to convene at 10:00 A.M., on the 30th day of March, A.D. 1942, to act upon:-
