By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of San Antonio, I hereby call you in Special Session, to be held at 10:00 o'clock A.M. on Tuesday, June 1st, 1943, for the purpose of transacting the following business:

"TO ACCEPT PROPOSAL OF MAGNOLIA PETROLEUM CO. TO FURNISH THE CITY WITH ITS REQUIREMENTS OF GASOLINE FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JUNE 17, 1943 AND ENDING DECEMBER 17, 1943;"

"TO ACCEPT PROPOSAL OF MARTIN-WRIGHT ELECTRIC CO. TO FURNISH THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH ITS REQUIREMENTS OF INCANDESCENT LAMPS FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JUNE 17, 1943 AND ENDING MAY 31, 1944."




On motion duly seconded and carried the meeting adjourned June 1, 1943.
