AN ORDINANCE *MD-255*

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio desire to facilitate the accounting of the funds derived from the sale of bonds dated September 1, 1919 which now remain on deposit in the various depositories herein named, Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. That warrants, to be made payable to the Chief Deputy City Treasurer of the City of San Antonio shall be drawn upon each of the City Depositories herein shown for the amounts of such deposits of such special funds derived from the sale of said bonds, said depositories and the amounts to be drawn from each such depository being as follows:

AM ORDINANCE *MD-256*

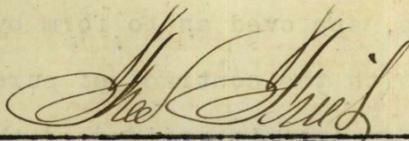
Appropriating \$11,163.05 to pay for winter uniforms for Police and Fire Depts.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Eleven Thousand, One Hundred and Sixty Three and 5/100 Dollars (\$11,163.05), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Frank Bros for winter uniforms supplied Police and Fire Departments per itemized invoices on file in office of City Auditor.

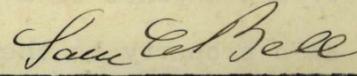
