PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Lambert, Heuermann, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

No. 54 - 990 AN ORDINANCE

Directing the payment of salaries and wages for services rendered by officers and employes of the City of San Antonio for the month of June, 1919, and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated for the payment of officers and employes for the several accounts and departments as specified in the attached schedule as salaries and wages for services rendered to the City during the month of June 1919, as per pay rolls:

for which amounts City warrants shall issue and be delivered to said respective payees; providing that all persons performing services for the City for uncertain periods, may be paid on pay rolls certified to be correct by the Commissioner of the Department or the Chief of the Division in which they are engaged, and such person so paid shall thereupon receipt said pay roll, all as provided by Charter.

Greene for 14 sectional maps of the City of San Antonio for use in making health survey of the City.

Commissioner Wright introduced the following resolution, which was adopted.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the International and Great Northern Railway Company be and is hereby directed to have a street arc lamp erected at the intersection of South Brazos Street with the railway tracks, the cost of maintenance of said arc lamp to be borne by said Railway Company.

Commissioner Wright recommended that the petition of the North Texas Oil and Refining Company for permit to erect buildings and storage tanks on lots 6, 7, 8, ~~and 9, N.C.B. 2580~~ 9, N.C.B. 2580, be granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Lambert recommended that petition of Amigos del Puebla for use of San Pedro Springs Park July 4, 5 and 6th be not granted, as the Park is taken for those dates.

Commissioner Lambert reported that he had taken up with the San Antonio Public Service Company the question of extension of street car service to the Municipal Rifle Range, and they declined to make the extension asked for at the present time.

The following resolution was read and adopted:

RESOLUTION

Directing the City Purchasing Agent to advertise for one Ford run about with Truck body for Mr Haenig, Sewer Inspector.


