----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition of Herman Laux et al, for correction of assessment; also petition of Alex Thomas, for refund of taxes, were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Petition of Church of God in Christ, for permit to build, was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

The following proposals for paving a part of Avenue D, and South St Mary Street were read and referred to City Engineer for tabulation, on motion of Commissioner Lambert, duly seconded and carried: Uvalde Rock Asphalt Company, Colglazier, Chapin Construction Co., Rushmore and Gowdy, Reynolds Con. On recommendation of the building Inspector all bids for constructing garage at Police Station were rejected.

Commissioner Uhr requested leave of absence on December 7, 1916, which was granted.

Commissioner Lambert presented the report of the Health Department on the inspection of Milk and restaurants, which was read and adopted.

Commissioner Uhr introduced the following resolution, which was read and adopted:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

WHEREAS, by a petition signed by a number of men on the Jitney route between the Post Office and Camp Wilson, and also a request from an officer acting as Chief of Staff, asking that the route of said Jitneys be changed in order that the service may be benefitted therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED that all cars in Local Street Transportation service running on the route known as the Post Office and Camp Wilson route, this resolution applies only to cars that enter Camp Wilson, will, in the future follow the present route from Camp Wilson to Van Ness Street thence on Van Ness to Austin Street, on Austin to Chestnut to Nolan Street, on Chestnut to Nolan Street, on Nolan to Nachogdches Street, on Nachogdches to East Houston Street, Avenue D., Travis, Main Avenue, Houston Street back to Nachodges and return over same route.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
