## AN ORDINANCE

GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO THE SAN ANTONIO TRANSIT COMPANY TO OPERATE MOTOR BUSES IN LOCAL STREET TRANSPORTATION.

On motion by Commissioner Hein, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan, and carried by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson, a portrait of former Mayor Maury Maverick, painted by Mr. Harry Wortham, was accepted by the Council. Commissioner Hein announced that the portrait will be hung in the Council Chamber alongside the portraits of other former Mayors of San Antonio in appropriate ceremonies at the next regular Council Meeting.

Bids for the selection of a depository for the funds of the City of San Antonio for the Fiscal Year 1944 were opened and publicly read and referred to the City Auditor for tabulation.

The Petition of residents in protest to the creation of a Sports Arena at River Road and Mulberry Street was presented by Mrs. Hetty S. Browne, 112 Anastacia Place. Mrs. Browne, Mrs. Dwight Allison, 102 Allison Drive, and Mrs. Lee Haythorne, 110 Allison Drive, addressed the Council in support of the protest petition. After discussion and on the motion of Commissioner Callaghan, seconded by Commissioner Hein, the Petition was referred to the Council sitting as a Committee of the Whole. The motion was carried by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson.
