

AN ORDINANCE 2012-09-20-0732

**AUTHORIZING A TEMPORARY CLOSURE MULTI-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ALLOWING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF SPECIFIED STATE RIGHT OF WAY ON BROADWAY FROM PARLAND TO 4TH STREET AND THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE CITY'S RIGHT OF WAY ON 4TH STREET FROM BROADWAY STREET TO ALAMO PLAZA IN CONNECTION WITH THE SÍCLOVÍA EVENT SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 7, 2012, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1. THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT IS FOR ONE (1) YEAR WITH A MUTUAL OPTION TO EXTEND AND CHANGE THE SICLOVIA EVENT DATE EACH YEAR FOR FOUR (4) ADDITIONAL YEARS.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2010 the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District received \$15.6 Million in funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention through the 2009 Communities Putting Prevention to Work (CPPW) Initiative funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds are being used to reduce and prevent obesity in children and adults by conducting activities in school and community settings across Bexar County in partnership with several local businesses and organizations, school districts, and other City of San Antonio departments; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the CPPW initiatives, the Metropolitan Health District sponsored the first and second Siclovía events to encourage citizens to increase the use of bicycles and other forms of physical activities; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2012 the Metro Health entered into an agreement with the YMCA and all future Siclovía events in will be funded and organized by the YMCA; and

**WHEREAS**, the third Siclovía will be held on October 7, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. by temporarily closing two miles of Broadway from Parland to 4<sup>th</sup> Street to allow bicyclists, skateboarders and pedestrians to move freely and to increase their use of bicycles and other forms of physical activity; and

**WHEREAS**, Broadway is a state-owned roadway and authorization must be requested from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the temporary closure of Broadway from Parland to 4th Street; and

**WHEREAS**, TxDOT's policy for authorization of temporary closures of state-maintained roadways are formally granted by agreement, which must be executed between governmental jurisdictions that will be impacted by the temporary road closures; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance will authorize a temporary closure Multi-year Agreement with the TxDOT to allow the temporary street closure of specified state right of way on Broadway from Parland to 4th Street and on City's right of way on 4th Street from Broadway to Alamo Plaza on October 7, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with the term of the agreement for one (1) year with a mutual option to extend and change the Siclovía event date each year for four (4) additional years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department staff will coordinate with the YMCA in developing the Traffic Control Plans that will be utilized during the temporary street closures; and

**WHEREAS**, this City Council action will ensure that the temporary street closure will be permitted for this event; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute a Temporary Closure Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation to allow the temporary street closure of Broadway from Parland to 4th Street and the temporary closure of the City's right of way on 4th Street from Broadway Street to Alamo Plaza for the city's Third Siclovía event which will be held on Sunday, October 7, 2012 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.


**SECTION 2.** There is no financial impact with this Ordinance.


