Brief Background

Terms are for two (2) years, and there are no term limitations. The aforementioned have agreed to serve an additional two year term which is due to expire on November 28, 2014. The WDC's Board is comprised of seventeen (17) members representing specific categories, as noted above.

The Westside Development Corporation was established by the City Council on June 8, 2006 to "foster economic development, promote the development and redevelopment of real estate within its target area, create viable urban communities, and preserve the character, culture and history of the Westside."



