

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, AUGUST 28TH, A.D.1919, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Sam C. Bell, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann, Wright. Absent, Lambert.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire & Police:
B.V.Motor Co. for permit to install gasoline tank, 102 S.Frio Street.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:

For the improvement of Roseborough Avenue.

S.A.Board of education, requesting closing of an alley running through C.B.2215

Protest of citizens against the granting of permit to I.& G.N.R.R.Co. to build a spur track on Salado Street, crossing Buena Vista Street.

Property owners on E.Quincey Street, requesting sanitary sewers and street improvements

Petition of merchants and business men not to allow construction of spur track in front of Block 227, and across Buena Vista Street, on Salado Street.

Petition to put bridge over creek ~~in~~(Martinez) on Georgia Ave.

AN ORDINANCE *MD-40*

Appropriating \$13.26 to pay H.Morris, taxes collected in error.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$13.26 (the School Boards proportion being \$3.56) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Back Tax Fund to pay H.Morris on account of taxes collected in error for the year 1915 on Lot 10, C.B.576.

AN ORDINANCE *-41*

Appropriating \$22.86 to pay express charges on one crate of bears.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$22.86 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Zoo Fund to pay Express charges on one crate containing two bears from Del Rio, Texas, for the City Zoo, warrant for same to be made payable to Fred Fries, City Clerk.

Appropriating \$55.00 to pay A.A. Moore.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$55.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay A.A. Moore for preparing four copies of the record of bonds to be dated Sept 1, 1919.

AN ORDINANCE -43

Appropriating \$246.05 to pay sundry merchants bills.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of two hundred, forty six and 5/100 dollars, (\$246.45) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay sundry merchants bills per itemized invoices on file in office of City Auditor.

AN ORDINANCE -44

Appropriating \$300.00 to pay one half of the rental of premises occupied by the United States Government Employment Bureau.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Three Hundred dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay one half of the rental of the premises occupied by the United States Employment Bureau to be paid in monthly installments of \$50.00 each beginning with the month of September, 1919.

AN ORDINANCE -45

Appropriating money to defray expenses for band concert at Koehler Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$117.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the Zoo Fund to pay expenses of band concert held in Koehler Park on August 24, 1919.

Commissioner Wright recommended that the petition of Erwin Menn for permit to install gasoline tank and pump at Carolina & S. Cherry Sts be granted. Adopted.

An ordinance to change the location of the alley running through C.B. 426 was read and laid over.

Bids for furnishing the City with gasoline for the month of September were opened and referred to the City Purchasing Agent.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
