

AN ORDINANCE **97743**

DESIGNATING CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE 2003-2005 CITY COUNCIL AS MAYOR PRO TEM FOR SPECIFIED PERIODS OF TIME FROM JUNE 5, 2003 THROUGH MAY 31, 2005, AND SWEARING IN OF THE MAYOR PRO TEM FOR THE PERIOD OF JUNE 5, 2003 THROUGH AUGUST 15, 2003, AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE UPON PASSAGE OF EIGHT (8) AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

WHEREAS, Section 9 of the City of San Antonio City Charter provides for a Mayor Pro Tem to act as Mayor during the absence or disability of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, a tradition has been established of rotating the Mayor Pro Tem position among all of the members of the Council other than the Mayor during each two-year term; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following named members of the City Council are hereby designated as Mayor Pro Tem of the City of San Antonio to serve during the periods indicated below:



SECTION 2. Should any of the above Council Members be replaced for any reason, such replacement shall be substituted for such member for the term indicated.

SECTION 3. Because of the necessity of having a Mayor Pro Tem to act in the absence or disability of the Mayor, the City Council deems an emergency exists, making it necessary to provide for an immediate effective date upon passage by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise, said effective date shall be ten (10) days from the date of passage hereof.

POLICY ANALYSIS:




COORDINATION:
