PRESENT: Honorable O.B.Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: For arc light at S.A & A.P.R.R. crossing at Georgia and Kensington Ave. For street lights on Lexington Avenue. Sunset System, for permit to erect bulletin boards, W.Commerce St. and Alazan Creek. Do. " " " " " " 1422 S.Flores Street. W.H.Cuevas, to install gasoline pump and tank 1004 Guadalupe Street. J.W.Kothmann & Son, for permit to erect slaughter house, at Colorado and Medio Streets, was read and referred to City Health Officer.

Petition of Lakeview Improvement Club, requesting City to donate street south side Euclid Park, was read second time and laid over.

Commissioner Wright recommended that petition of Jose B.Elizondo for permit to install gasoline pump and tank at 1329 S.Laredo street be granted. Adopted.

A proposal from M.W.Craven to purchase Kelley truck from City was rejected, and the City Purchasing Agent authorized to advertise for bids for sale of same.

An ordinance providing for the closing of an unnamed street across the property of the Lone Star Cotton Mills between Jones Ave. and the San Antonio River was read and laid over.

The Bid of the Prudential Cafe for feeding inmates of the hospital ward at Police and Fire Station was accepted, on recommendation of City Purchasing Agent.

Bid of Coleman & Jenkins for concrete floor in swimming pool at San Pedro Park was opened and referred to City Engineer.

AN ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with A.D.Politis concerning concessions in various parks in the City of San Antonio, was read once and laid over.

A petition to have S.Hackberry Street widened from Steves Avenue to Topeka Boulevard by the City purchasing a strip of land, was granted, and the City Attorney instructed to draw necessary ordinance covering same.

RESOLUTION

A resolution extending the time for receiving bids for printing of 1000 volumes of Revised City Ordinances.

WHEREAS on the 13 day of November A.D.1922, by a resolution duly passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, the City Purchasing Agent is authorized and instructed to advertise for bids for the printing of 1000 Volumes of Revised City Ordinances of the City of San Antonio, which bids were to have been filed not later than 4 o'clock p.m. on Thursday Nov. 27, 1922, and

WHEREAS, the time provided for such resolutions were deemed insufficient,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the time for the receiving of such bids be and it is hereby extended so that such bids should be received up to 4 o'clock p.m. December 4, 1922, and that the City Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized and instructed to advertise for such bids up to the time and date herein last above set out.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the San Antonio Metal Sign Company was granted the right to set the street signs in the first fire limits, or business district, to a height of ten feet above the sidewalk, this being in the interest of certain traffic.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
