

AN ORDINANCE 33189

NAMING A SPECIAL CANVASSING BOARD FOR ABSENTEE VOTES CAST IN THE APRIL 6, 1965, MUNICIPAL ELECTION; AND AMENDING SEC. 2 OF ORDINANCE 33109, PROVIDING FOR VOTING PRECINCT POLLING PLACES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The Special canvassing board to count and canvass all absentee votes and ballots cast at the April 6, 1965, municipal election shall consist of the Mayor, or the Mayor Pro-Tem, as presiding judge, and the City Clerk and Councilman ROBERT C. JONES as clerks.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Ordinance 33109 is hereby amended to add the following:


<u>"PRECINCT NO.</u>	<u>POLLING PLACE</u>
146	That part of Voting Precinct No. 146 now within the City Limits of San Antonio, consolidated with Precinct No. 148, Oak Hills Bowling Lanes, 5139 Fredericksburg Road."

SECTION 3. Section 2 of Ordinance 33109 is hereby amended to delete the provision therein as to a polling place for Voting Precinct No. 147.


