AN ORDINANCE (847)

DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF CLOTHING LIKE AN OFFICER, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. It shall be unlawful for any person, not a member thereof, to wear any uniform identical with the uniform worn by any uniformed member of the Police Department or the Fire Department of the City of San Antonio.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person not a member thereof to wear any uniform or parts thereof so similar to the uniform worn by any uniformed member of the Fire Department or the Police Department of the City of San Antonio in a manner calculated to deceive or mislead the public as to his identity.

3. "Uniform" shall include the cap, badge, blouse, trousers, leggings, additional official insignia and any other habiliments worn by any uniformed member of the Fire Department or the Police Department of the City of San Antonio.

4. Any person violating this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$200.00.

5. If any part of this ordinance be held invalid or inoperative, the remainder thereof shall not be affected by such invalidity or inoperation.

6. All laws, ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

7. This ordinance is declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent therefrom, and it shall take effect from the date of its passage by a four-fifths vote of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio; and it is so ordered.
