SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,
HELD IN THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, IN THE CITY HALL, SAN ANTONIO,
TEXAS, AT 12:05 O'CLOCK, P.M., ON FRIDAY, JUNE 30th, 1944.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein and Anderson. ABSENT: Steffler. Mayor Mauermann presiding.

The Clerk read the call, as follows:
