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## AN ORDINANCE 9387

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PASSED AND APPROVED 3 NOVEMBER, 1938, ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE HEIGHT, NUMBER OF STORIES AND SIZE OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES; PER CENT OF LOT THAT MAY BE OCCUPIED; THE SIZE OF YARDS, COURTS AND OPEN SPACES; DENSITY OF POPULATION; LOCATION AND USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES AND LAND FOR TRADE, INDUSTRY, RESIDENCE AND OTHER PURPOSES; DIVIDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO INTO DISTRICTS, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, RE-CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REPAIR OR USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES OR LAND WITHIN SUCH DISTRICT; PROVIDING THE UNIFORM REGULATIONS FOR CLASSES OR KINDS OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES AND USES WITH-IN THE RESTRICTED DISTRICT; ADOPTING ZONING MAP DISCLOSING VARIOUS DISTRICTS,

USE, AREAS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS AND PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO DISTRICTS AND AREAS; PROVIDING FOR A BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND DEFINING THE POWERS THEREOF; TO AMEND SECTION 2, PARAGRAPH 4 BY THE ADDITION OF PARAGRAPH 4A: TO RE-ZONE: PROPOSITION B, PORTION OF WEST HILDEBRAND AVENUE; PROPOSITION C, PORTION OF CULEBRA ROAD; PROPOSITION D, 4800 BLOCK OF SOUTH ZARZAMORA STREET; PROPOSITION E, PORTION OF WEST MARTIN STREET; PROPOSITION F, CULEBRA AND BANDERA ROAD; PROPOSITION G, PORTION OF TERRACE STREET; ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS ORDINANCE OR THE OWNER OF ANY BUILDING OR PREMISES OR PART THEREOF WHERE ANYTHING IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PLACED OR SHALL EXIST, AND ANY ARCHITECT, BUILDER, CONTRACTOR, AGENT, PERSON OR CORPORATION EMPLOYED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, WHO MAY HAVE ASSISTED IN THE COMMISSION OF ANY SUCH VIOLATION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A SEPARATE OFFENSE AND UPON CONVICTION MAY BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$100.00 AND EACH DAY SUCH VIOLATION EXISTS SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE. PASSED AND APPROVED 14th APRIL, 1949.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ETC.", passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 3rd day of November, A.D. 1938, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

2. PROPOSITION A:

That Section 2, paragraph 4 of the above described Zoning Ordinance be and the same is amended hereby by the addition of paragraph 4A as follows:

"4A. No residence building may be hereafter erected on a lot or plot with less than forty (40) feet on a street and no property may be subdivided into lots or plots with less than forty (40) feet on a dedicated street except as provided in Section 21, paragraph 51."

3. PROPOSITION B:

Recommendation of the Zoning Commission that lots 6 and 7, Block 5, New City Block 3932, on West Hildebrand Avenue, remain as "F" LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT, instead of being changed to "J" COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, as petitioned by Grant Thomas, was not accepted but the petition was referred back to the Zoning Commission for further study.

9. All Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed, and the present classification of said area is discontinued.

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AN ORDINANCE 9390

AMENDING A LEASE BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND WILLIAM REILLY JR. AND EDWIN REILLY, A PARTNERSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. This ordinance amends a contract of lease between the City of San Antonio, as Lessor, a municipal corporation of the County of Bexar and State of Texas, and William Reilly Jr. and Edwin Reilly, a partnership, Lessee, of the County of Bexar and State of Texas as given and granted by virtue of an Ordinance passed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio and dated September 29, 1947 and amended November 28, 1947.

W I T N E S S E T H

Said lease as authorized and given by said Ordinance of September 29, 1947 and amended November 28, 1947, is hereby amended and changed as follows; to-wit:

I

Paragraph 3, is hereby changed so that same shall hereafter read as follows:

3. Approximately 9600 square feet contained in the North Half of Building 658.

II

Paragraph 5, is hereby amended and changed so that same shall hereafter read as follows:

5. The amount of the rent for this property is \$225.00 per month payable monthly in advance on or before the 10th of the month at the Office of the License and Dues Collector of the Lessor, in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, at the rate of \$225.00 each month for the term hereof, and in addition to the charges specified herein.

The amendments contained herein shall be effective as of March 31, 1949.

III

Said lease as executed by virtue of said Ordinance of September 29, 1947, except as expressly changed herein, shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

1. That this ordinance makes and manifests a lease by and between the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, whose postoffice address is City Hall, San Antonio, 5, Texas, for itself, its successors and assigns, hereinafter called the Lessor, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the Government;

WITNESSETH: The parties hereto for the considerations hereinafter mentioned covenant and agree as follows:

2. That the Lessor hereby leases to the Government the following described premises, viz:

A tract of land situated in the County of Bexat, State of Texas, being part of the Manuel Leal Survey No. 30, and being more particularly described as follows; all bearings being referred to true north:

From the intersection of the center line of the right-of-way for Cemetery Road and the center line of the right-of-way for U.S. Highway No. 281 south 00° 07' west, 1076.2 feet along said center line of the right-of-way for U.S. Highway No. 281 to a point; thence north 89° 53' west, 60.0 feet to the point of beginning, said point of beginning being on the westerly line of said right-of-way for U.S. Highway No. 281; thence from said point of beginning, south 00° 07' west, 1210.0 feet along said westerly right-of-way line to a point; thence

north 89° 53' west, 780.0 feet to a point being in a southerly projection of fence line running approximately North-South; thence north 00° 07' east, 1210.0 feet along said line and fence to a point; thence south 89° 53' east, 780.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 21.66 acres, more or less; including buildings Nos. T-307, 309, 319, 332, 344, 345, and 347, and the lands thereunder, which buildings are located on the land area described above; as outlined in red on the attached map, and equipment installed in said buildings as listed on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part of this instrument.

3. Said property to be used for Ground National Guard activities.

4. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with their appurtenances for the term beginning 28 October 1947 through 30 June 1948.

5. This lease may be mutual agreement be renewed from year to year at a rental of One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) per annum, and otherwise upon the terms and conditions herein specified, provided notice of intention of renewal be given in writing to the Lessor at least thirty (30) days before this lease or any renewal thereof would otherwise expire; Provided that no renewal thereof shall extend the period of occupancy of the premises beyond 30 June 1953.

6. The Government shall pay the Lessor rent at the following rate: One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) per annum. Payment shall be made at the end of each fiscal year by the Finance Officer, United States Army, Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

7. The Government shall have the right, during the existence of this lease, to attach fixtures, and erect additions, structures, or signs, in or upon the premises hereby leased; which fixtures, additions and structures, or signs, so placed in, upon or attached to the said premises shall be and remain the property of the Government and may be removed or otherwise disposed of by the Government prior to the termination of this lease; and, the Government shall surrender possession of the premises upon the termination of this lease in as good condition as that existing on 10 July 1941, the time of entering upon the same under Lease No. W-359-eng-3686, reasonable and ordinary wear and tear and damages by the elements or by circumstances over which the Government has no control, excepted. The Government shall have the right of making a cash settlement with the Lessor in lieu of performance of this obligation, by a mutually acceptable settlement, and the parties shall enter into a supplemental agreement effectuating such settlement.

8. The Government may terminate this lease at any time by giving thirty (30) days notice in writing to the Lessor, and no rental shall accrue after the effective date of termination.

9. Any notice under the terms of this lease shall be in writing signed by a duly authorized representative of the party giving such notice, and if given by the Government shall be addressed to the Lessor at the City Hall, San Antonio, 5, Texas, and if given by the Lessor shall be addressed to the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, Santa Fe Building, Galveston, Texas.

10. The Lessor may enter upon the area for the purpose of maintenance, operation, and servicing of the utility lines, buildings, and other property the ownership of which the Lessor retains.

11. The Lessor warrants that he has not employed any person to solicit or secure this lease upon any agreement for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee. Breach of this warranty shall give the Government the right to annul the lease, or, in its discretion, to deduct from the rental the amount of such commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fees. This warranty shall not apply to commissions payable by lessors upon contracts or leases secured or made through bonafide established commercial or selling agencies maintained by the Lessor for the purpose of securing business.

12. No Member of or Delegate to Congress or Resident Commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this lease or to any benefit that may arise therefrom, but this provision shall not be construed to extend to this lease if made with a corporation for its general benefit.

13. This lease supersedes and cancels Lease No. W-359-2ng-3686 insofar only as the premises covered hereby are affected.

14. The foregoing instrument in writing constitutes the entire contract of lease of said property, all other agreements being hereby abrogated, it being understood that the Charter of the City of San Antonio requires all contracts of the City to be made in writing by the Board of Commissioners.
