That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to issue warrants for the payment of wages to City Day Laborers for the week ending Aug 31, 1916, that the following sums be and are hereby appropriated out of the several special funds for that purpose, to-wit:

An ordinance accepting proposal of Young and Ramsey for constructing sewer on Trinity Avenue and authorizing contract and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposal of said party named in the caption hereof, dated _____ to construct sanitary sewer on Trinity Street, from Alazan Main to Ruiz Street, to and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and description and drawings prepared and submitted by City Engineer provided said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this ordinance and all instruments herein referred to, which are made a part hereof.

Section 2. (Bonds) That the Mayor is hereby authorized to require and approve on behalf of the City proper bond or bonds for the performance and completion of said undertakings.

Section 3. (Contract) That the Mayor is hereby authorized to cause and require the execution and delivery of a written contract to be drawn in accordance with said proposal, and the terms and conditions understood and required as applicable to said matter.

Section 4. (Appropriation) That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, the sum of Fourteen Hundred Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 General Fund.

MB-107 AN ORDINANCE

Granting permit to C.H.Kearny to construct sanitary sewer in Berkshire Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted C.H.Kearny to construct an eight inch sanitary sewer in Berkshire Avenue, from the stub off South Presa Street eastward towards Kinney Street to a point in front of lot No. 2, City Block No. 1682, the estimated cost of said sewer being \$_____ to be paid by said C.H.Kearny.

Section 2. That said sewer when completed to become the property of the City of San Antonio and a part of its public sewer system.

Section 3. The City Engineer is hereby directed to collect the sum of Thirty Five Dollars for each and every connection made with said sewer main (with the exception of lots 2 and 4 in City Block No. 1682, and lot No. 7, City Block No. 1675, which connections are already paid for) and pay the same over to said C.H.Kearny, not later than the 10th day of every month following the month in which said connection is made, until the sum of \$_____ shall have been collected and paid over as aforesaid, when no further connection fee of \$35.00 shall be collected.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
