MONDAY, JANUARY 8th, A.D. 1923, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Hon. J.P. Pfeiffer, Mayor, pro tem, presiding, and Commissioners Lambert, Rieden, Wright. Absent, Mayor Black.

Minutes of previous meetings were ordered approved.

## ----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Petition for the closing of Gladys Street, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets, and Public Improvements.

A resolution fixing the north boundary of the S.A. River, between Navarro Street and N. Presa Street, was read and referred to City Attorney.

Petition of F.B. Griffin, for correction of assessment was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

Commissioner Wright recommended that petition of Gulf Refining Co. for permit to erect electric sign at Fredericksburg Road and Blanco Road be granted. Adopted.

The City Engineer recommended that the petition of property owners on Dawson Street to have same paved be granted, but no action was taken on the recommendation.
