REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN
THE CITY COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL,
ON THURSDAY, MARCH 14, 1957 AT 9:30 A.M.

PRESENT: FRIEDRICH, BAINES, PASSUR, WINTON, KUYKENDALL, OLIVARES, SAN MARTIN

ABSENT: CRUMRINE, DANIELS

Mayor J. Edwin Kuykendall presiding.

Invocation by Rev. Nelson Prior Patterson, St. Josephs A.M.E

On motion of Mr. Baines, seconded by Mr. Passur, the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

Zoning Case No. 736E to zone property to the north and west of the present zoned part of the City, which property is now shown to be "A" TEMPORARY RESIDENCE was called up.

Mr. Skrivanek representing the Planning Director went over the entire proposal with the Councilmen giving reasons for the various recommendations by the Planning Commission.

Mr. Leslie Necker of 119 Ave Maria Drive protested against the designation of property to the south of him as anything but "A" RESIDENTIAL.

Mr. Henry Lee Taylor, Attorney for W. A. Kelly, who owns 165 acres in the area in three different locations, protested against potential business and trackage property being designated as residential or apartment property. After long discussion, Mr. Matthews, the City Manager, suggested that the Council be supplied with a land use map of the area before deciding what to do.

Mr. Olivares moved that the case be continued for two weeks which was unanimously voted favorably; later in the meeting a recommendation of this vote resulted in making the continuation for three weeks or until April 4th.

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The Council then took up the hearing on pest control which was continued from last week. Mr. Gardner, the Attorney for the Pest Control Association, again gave reasons for the ordinance and asked for its passage. Mr. Villareal, Attorney for some independent operators, objected to some of the provisions of the ordinance while agreeing with its purpose in principle. He asked that time be given for consultations in which an ordinance could be worked out which might be more satisfactory to all. Mr. John Reeves urged the adoption of the ordinance as proposed. Mr. Daniel Pena objected to several features.

Mr. Winton suggested that it might be well to get the opinion of the Administrative Staff of the City and the City Attorney. He then moved that the hearing be continued three weeks or until April 4th.

The motion was unanimously carried.
