

FEBRUARY 24, 1944

REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,  
HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS,  
AT 10:00 O'CLOCK, A. M. ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 24TH, 1944.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein and Anderson. ABSENT: Steffler. Mayor Mauermann presiding.

The Clerk read the Minutes of the preceding meeting, and after a motion by Commissioner Hein, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan, they were approved as read by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein and Anderson. Nay, Steffler (Absent).

Petitions were presented as follows:

Three petitions from the Magnolia Petroleum Company asking permission to make the following changes in gasoline equipment:

To replace a 10-gallon visible gasoline pump with an Electric Computing Gasoline pump at the White House Garage, 505 Roosevelt Avenue;

To replace one five barrell leaky underground storage tank at the Star Garage, 213 North St. Mary's Street;

To install one ten barrell underground storage tank and one Electric Computing pump at the Bedell Building Garage, 510 East Travis Street;

all of which petitions were referred to the Commissioner of Fire and Police for action.

Two petitions from the Humble Oil & Refining Company for permission to install underground storage tanks at the following locations:

One 1000 gallon tank at 1102 San Pedro Avenue;

Two 1000 gallon tanks at 601 Fredericksburg Road;

both of which petitions were referred to the Commissioner of Fire and Police for action.

Petition of H. C. Thorman to change the name of a short street between Clyde Street and Audubon Street to some other name than the present one of Belknap Street because of the confusion arising, due to its similarity to the name "Belknap Place", which petition was referred to the Street Commissioner for action.

Petition of S. K. Lockhart requesting exemption of taxes on the house at 1615 Buena Vista Street, being Lot 9, Block 3, N. C. B. 2312 owned by the Prospect Hill Missionary Baptist Church, which was referred to the Tax Commissioner for action.



Mayor Mauermann announced the appointment of Rev. C. Tranchese, R. S. Atchison, and Edwin R. Simmang as members of the Housing Authority of the City of San Antonio, to serve for a term of two years beginning on the 24th day of February, 1944.


