#### Description:

On January 31, 2013, City Council authorized the submission of six project proposals for consideration and funding through the new Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) arm of the “Texas Healthcare Transformation and Quality Improvement Program” (Medicaid 1115 Waiver). Metro Health carefully selected projects in the following areas: diabetes prevention, children’s oral health services, HIV and syphilis prevention, breastfeeding promotion, teen pregnancy prevention and neighborhood health promotion. All six projects were approved for funding through two phases of approvals in April and September of 2013.

The HIV and syphilis prevention project (Project) was established in order develop innovative ways to address the significant sexually transmitted disease (STD) epidemic burdening our community. The Project’s main purpose is to assist in the expansion of STD/HIV outreach and field testing to reduce incidence rates of HIV and syphilis in high morbidity zip codes by targeting individuals at risk for contracting HIV and/or syphilis.
